



SET-PRICE ELECTIVE LAPAROSCOPIC SURGICAL PROCEDURES

OVARIOHYSTERECTOMY <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be <1 year of age • NOT in heat 	CRYPTORCHID NEUTER <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be <2 years of age
Cost = \$1500	Cost = \$1650

Required pre-op blood work:

- PCV/TS and mini-chem within 1 month of surgery (If not performed by family veterinarian, can be done at PESCM for an additional fee)

Includes:

- Initial consultation
- Individualized anesthetic protocol and pain management plan
- Surgical procedure with all equipment/supplies
- Medications as needed to go home

Discharge:

- Most patients are discharged THE EVENING OF SURGERY

Does NOT Include:

- Other surgical procedures (ie. deciduous teeth extractions, mass removals)
- Treatment of anesthetic or other complications
- Overnight hospitalization

PROPHYLACTIC GASTROPEXY <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To prevent GDV in HEALTHY, large-breed patients • Dogs at least 8 months of age 	Cost = \$1800 if performed alone <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dogs of ANY AGE 	Cost = \$400 as an ADD-ON to laparoscopic spay or cryptorchid neuter <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dogs < 1 year of age • Best BEFORE 1st HEAT CYCLE if combined with spay
	Cost = \$1850 for laparoscopic gastropexy with standard neuter <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dogs of ANY AGE 	

Pre-op blood work:

- PCV/TS & mini-chem if <5 yrs of age, otherwise full CBC & chemistry panel with urinalysis (If not performed by family veterinarian, can be done at PESCM for an additional fee)

Includes:

- Initial consultation
- Individualized anesthetic protocol and pain management plan
- Surgical procedure with all equipment/supplies
- Medications as needed to go home

Discharge:

- Most patients are discharged THE EVENING OF SURGERY

Does NOT Include:

- Other surgical procedures (ie. mass removal, biopsy of internal organs, urolith removal)
- Treatment of anesthetic or other complications
- Overnight hospitalization
